Welcome to Grace Mennonite Fellowship!

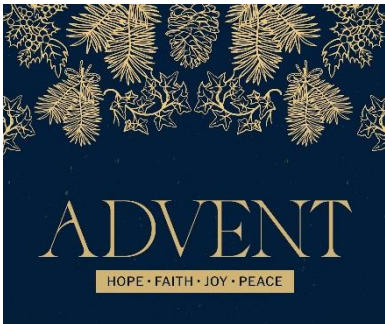
